## **NON-RESIDENT STUDENT CONTRACT**

### **Preface:**

Students attending Whitesville Central School are privileged to be part of an outstanding educational program. Academic and extra-curricular activities are emphasized in the proper balance so that all students have the opportunity to participate and succeed in both areas.

Whitesville Central School welcomes orderly, well-mannered students from outside of the district when possible.

Any student who is or will be a senior during his/her first year as a nonresident Whitesville Central School student must be on an academic track to graduate in his/her home school in order for us to consider his/her request for admission to Whitesville Central School.

### **The School's Commitment:**

The staff will provide each individual non-resident student with the same privileges and programs as students living within the district, provided the student adheres to this contract.

### **The Student's Commitment:**

Admittance and continued attendance at Whitesville Central School is based upon the following performance criteria:

1. Students riding a Whitesville bus will conduct themselves in a cooperative and appropriate manner. If a non-resident student becomes a discipline concern on a Whitesville Central School bus, his/her riding privileges may be revoked. If the student has no other way to get to school, he/she will lose the privilege of attending Whitesville Central School as an out-of-district student.
2. Whitesville students must abide by the attendance policy as outlined in the Student Handbook. If an out-of-district student becomes an attendance concern, (i.e. tardiness or absences) the student's enrollment at Whitesville will be reviewed. The principal reserves the right to terminate the out-of-district privilege.
3. Excellent behavior at school and at all school related events will be expected. If a non-resident student becomes a discipline problem, the principal reserves the right to terminate the out-of-district privilege.

4. While academic success will vary from individual-to-individual, it is expected that each student will strive to do his/her best. Poor work habits or refusal to take advantage of the educational opportunities provided will not be acceptable. If a non-resident student is not being academically successful and the school determines that he/she is not making sufficient effort to improve the situation, the principal reserves the right to terminate the out-of-district privilege.

**Summary:**

The opportunity to attend Whitesville Central School from outside of the district is a privilege. Abuse of the above standards may lead to dismissal from the student body at Whitesville.

By signing below, the parties involved indicate that they are in agreement with the provisions outlined above and agree to abide by the stipulations of this contract.
