Program Notes

The 2nd Grade's rendition of *You're a Mean One Mr. Grinch* has some unique parts to it. The class worked together to come up with their own words and rhythms to play with each verse. Each verse has its own chant that relates back to the lyrics. 2nd Grade worked hard at creating their ostinatos (a short repeated musical pattern) and is excited to share them with you.

The 6th Grade Class Song was composed by this year's 6th grade class. Each member of the class created their own two measures of music and then the class arranged their rhythms into the order they liked best.

This year our high school band students have had the opportunity to work on chamber ensemble playing. Chamber ensembles are small groups such as quartets and quintets. While learning about performance practice with this different type of ensemble the ensemble members have learned how to play without a conductor. The members of these groups have learned to communicate visually and with the music to perform their songs start to finish by themselves. This will be seen in the Woodwind Ensemble's rendition of *Ode to Joy* and the Brass Ensemble's *Minuet*. *Ode to Joy* will feature senior Paige Chase on the flute and *Minuet* will feature senior Jessica Erdmann on the trumpet.
